

SURREY MAYORS CUP 2017

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- When do we register?

Answer: Surrey Mayor's Cup is a premier tournament that is sold out every year. It is recommended to register as soon as registration opens to avoid disappointment. Registration is only complete if payment is processed in full.

- How can we register?

Answer: Teams can only register online. Payments have to be completed in order for a team to register.

- Are teams eligible for refunds?

Answer: All registrations at Surrey mayors Cup are final. Refunds will only be issued at the discretion of the tournament director.

- How is the quality of fields for SMC?

Answer: SMC is played on premier fields in City of Surrey. All fields are in top shape and in the past 3 years we haven't cancelled any games for the tournaments.

- Where do I pick up the Tournament Package from?

Answer: The tournament package is to be picked up from Newton Athletic Park Club house. A fully completed list of roster of players must also be dropped off at the same time.

- Are we required to provide team list at every game?

Answer: This is optional provided the tea list is submitted at the tournament headquarters.

- What does a team do in regards with MVP medal if they haven't picked up their package?

Answer: Both teams still pick the MVP as normal. The team with the medal can give the medal to their own player and once the team without the medal have picked their package up they could provide their MVP from that game with the medal.

- Who picks the MVP?

Answer: The coach of the opposing team picks the MVP and one player could only be named MVP once in the tournament.

- Where do we report the Scores?

Answer: Score reporting can be done by calling on the phone numbers provided in the score reporting section of the tournament rules.

- Where do I find the standings?

Answer: The standings are found live on www.surreymayorscup.com. The standing are updated within 20 mins of the score verification.

- Who all need to report their scores?

Answer: All teams from U13-U18 win or lose must report their scores. Scores are not published online till verified by both teams. This must be done within 15 mins of finishing your game.

- What do I have to do to file a protest?

Answer: The protest must be filed at Newton Athletic Park and the instructions of how to file a protest are clearly mentioned in the SMC rules of play.

- Where do teams get their medals?

Answer: All teams from U9-U12 will pick up the participation medals in their tournament package. All teams from U13-U18 must come to Newton Athletic Park and proceed to the main stage to pick up their medals. Medals will only be provided only after verification by the score keeping team.
